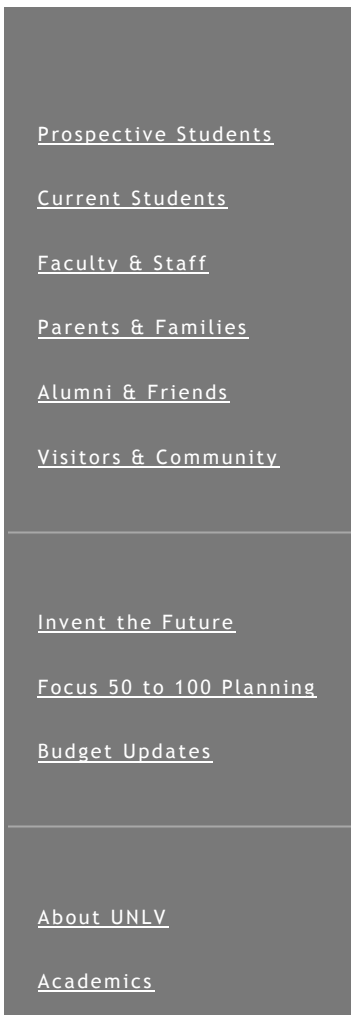


## 1. Registration for UNLV Credit Course.

- a. Go to <http://www.unlv.edu/main/indexpage.html>
- b. Go to Admission Information.
- c. Look on Left-hand side of page in dark grey area under “Other” and click on “Just Want to Take a Class.”
- d. Choose “Non-degree Seeking Student” or “Admitted Student.” Follow instructions.
- e. For a Non-degree seeking student:
  - (1) Fill out form and pay online. Cost will be \$30.00 and don’t forget to save a copy. It will take several days for the form to be processed.
  - (2) Once your form is processed, you will then be able to register for a class online at UNLV. To check on the status of your form, please call Karen Maldonado at 895-3320.

**Non-Degree Seeking Student  
(also referred to as a Special Student)**

university admission requirements or missed the application deadline, but still wish to enroll for classes.

- A person wishing to enroll in a course for personal or professional fulfillment.
- Visiting students who want to enroll in UNLV courses and then transfer credits to their home institution.

As a non-degree seeking student, you are not eligible for federal financial aid or state aid. A maximum of 24 undergraduate credits and 15 graduate credits can be considered for transfer credit as an admitted student.

NOTE: Remedial-level courses will not be considered as a transferable course in the UNLV admission process. Please check the UNLV admission requirements page for more information.
